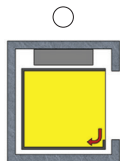

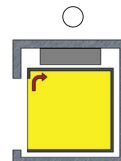
Front Entry
RH Gate



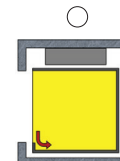
Right Side Entry

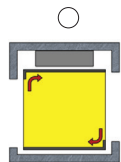

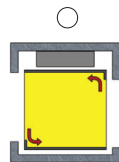

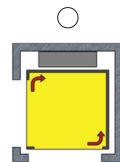

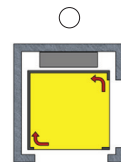
Straight-Thru

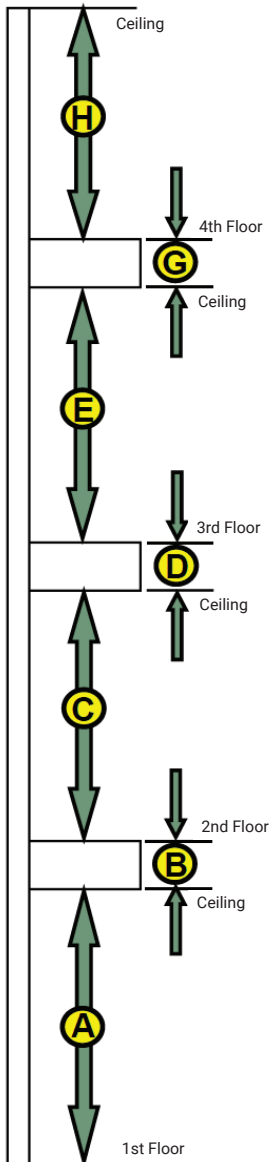

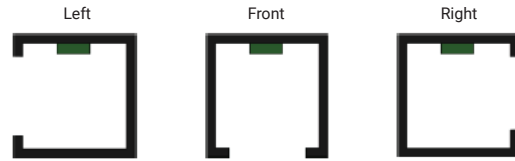
